Well, this is what I did...


I took off the Jeep steel bumper extensions off.... but it exposed the back of the LED fog lights which I had to pick stuff out and did not want to break any of the wires in the plug housing....



So this is what it looks like now...



It cost me two trips to Lowes, one for my wife.... \$5.00 of aluminum sheet



So the process... cut the 6x18 in half.... and made some templates....







I noticed that my template fit for both left and right side... just reverse it... So I made a template of both and it works....

Painted with this... good match and got the info from the forum.







Painted it and it dried quickly... Less than 30 minutes.
