

Jeep Delivery Checklist

Stuff to bring for your inspection: Creeper, Flashlight, CD or phone, USB phone cord, small plug 115v light

Verify the following properly comes with your vehicle:

- Two sets of keys
- Jeep tool kit for the right model
- Lug nut key, if applicable
- Freedom top storage bag
- Floor mats – cloth (std) or rubber depending on your options
- Owner’s manual – infotainment
- Jeep hitch receiver rubber insert for tow group
- Small baggie with tubing and splices for tow group
- Black fuel filler door on Rubicon
- 33inch BFG KM02 on Rubicon
- Rock rails on Rubicon
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Verify the following are of proper quality:

- Body welds – there should be nice even heating no splatter
- Inspect undercarriage for any major rust
- Inspect for any leaks, oil, transmission, exhaust, etc.
- Inspect paint for scratches
- Check oil drain plug and oil filter for proper tightening
- Inspect tires and ensure minimal balancing weights were needed
- Shake tires and ensure minimal play in the wheels
- Inspect control arm bolts for proper torque
- Verify tire pressure at manufacturer recommended 37psi
- Inspect all seams for consistency
- Verify all fluid levels are within acceptable range
- Inspect wiring for any cuts or splices
- Verify interior is clean and no soiling has occurred from the factory
- Verify carpet is properly fastened and no signs of lifting
- Carefully inspect the paint job for imperfections – indicate to dealer
- Mileage should be under 25 miles

Verify the following works as intended:

- Heat and AC works including fans, etc.
- Freedom Top properly removes and ensure it is properly fastened prior to leaving
- Take vehicle for a quick test drive and ensure gas, brakes, clutch, etc
- Test functionality of all options you ordered
- Inspect all lights for functionality: interior and exterior including high beams and reverse
- Windshield wipers
- No warning lights are showing once started
- Crank the engine and listen for any weird noises
- Test the horn
- Lower and Raise the windows
- Steering wheel lowers and raises and telescopes as designed
- Seats recline and easily move forward and backward
- Safety belts

Allow the salesperson to provide a full demonstration of all functionality

- Install shorty antenna – Ha you are already mod’n your Jeep!
- Install Infotainment Protector – Second mod while at dealership!
- Fill-up gas tank when you take the vehicle for a test drive
- Inquire if all recalls have been performed – such as steering prgm update
- Inspect that no dealer badges were put on your vehicle
- Insure you are given the vehicle registration and all paperwork
- Inquire as to when the title will be provided to you, if not financing
- Signed up for Jeep Wave program
- Get a schedule of all maintenance required for the vehicle over its lifetime
- Verify you are in 2Hi and drive home and enjoy your badass vehicle!
- Remember you are in the break-in period for the engine: first 60 under 50, smooth acceleration, after 60 miles up to 55mph are desirable. While cruising (high gear) brief full-throttle acceleration for a good break-in
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
