Verify Build Quality

- ☐ Check body welds for pitting, excessive
rust, incomplete fusion, etc.
- ☐ Inspect frame/undercarriage for major
rust
- ☐ Check underside for leaks - oil,
transmission, exhaust, etc.
- ☐ Check oil drain plug and oil filter tightness
- ☐ Inspect paint for scratches, bubbling,
overspray and imperfections. Note
deficiencies in writing
- ☐ Shake tires and ensure minimal play in
wheels (???)
- ☐ Inspect control arm bolts for proper torque
- ☐ Check steering rods and shimmy
dampeners for looseness (Death Wobble).
- ☐ Verify that shimmy dampers show a
revision # of ____ or later

<input type="checkbox"/>	Check all body seams for consistency and proper alignment	<hr/>
<input type="checkbox"/>	Verify engine serviced with 5 quarts of engine oil, not 6 (6 is for the JK, JL is different)	<hr/>
<input type="checkbox"/>	Verify all other fluids within acceptable ranges	<hr/>
<input type="checkbox"/>	Inspect wiring harnesses for cuts, splices, crimps	<hr/>
<input type="checkbox"/>	Verify interior clean with no stains	<hr/>
<input type="checkbox"/>	Verify seat covers in new condition (no cuts, abrasions, markets, etc.)	<hr/>
<input type="checkbox"/>	Verify carpet is properly fastened and no signs of lifting (if equipped)	<hr/>
<input type="checkbox"/>	Note mileage (should be approx. 25 mi or less). Ensure dealer notes correct mileage in computer for warranty purposes	<hr/>
<input type="checkbox"/>	Physically check all fuses/relays to ensure they are properly seated (Known issue)	<hr/>
<input type="checkbox"/>	Check hood/grill gaps for consistency	<hr/>
<input type="checkbox"/>	Verify that all known recalls and TSB's have been performed/complied with	<hr/>

- Get copy of all sales paperwork -- all loan documents, title application, bill of sale, registration application, warranty notices, extended warranty terms, arbitration agreements, original window sticker, etc.
- ☐ Scan and secure at home
- ☐ Get routine maintenance schedule for lifetime of vehicle
- ☐ Inquire about timeframe for delivery of title (if not financing)
- ☐ Inquire about timeframe for delivery of license plates (if in-state purchase)
- ☐ Sign up for Jeep Wave program
- ☐ Get copy of vehicle maintenance records
- ☐ Install Stubby Antenna (optional - your first mod!)

- ☐ Verify you are in 2-HI and drive your badass vehicle home and enjoy!

Remember You are in the engine break-in period. Drive accordingly.

Some rough break-in guidelines from other forum users (YMMV, use at your own risk, always read the manual):

First 60 under 50. Then max 55-60mph up to 300 miles. One full throttle acceleration to seat the rings.
